MARY RENAULT PRIZE 2022

The Principal and Fellows of St Hugh's College offer two or more Prizes, worth up to £500, for essays on classical reception or influence submitted by pupils who, at the closing date, have been in the Sixth Form of any school or college for a period of not more than two years. At least one prize will be awarded a pupil who is not studying either Latin or Greek to A-level standard.

Essays can be from any discipline and should be on a topic relating to the reception of classical antiquity – including Greek and Roman literature, history, political thought, philosophy, and material remains – in any period to the present; essays on reception within classical antiquity (for instance, receptions of literary or artistic works or of mythical or historical figures) are permitted.

Entries should be between two thousand and four thousand words and submitted by the candidate as a Microsoft Word document, together with the Mary Renault Prize Cover Sheet, through the form on the College website:
