Prices quoted are exclusive of call-out charges, fitting costs and VAT.

College reserves the right to charge a higher price than that quoted on the list which reflects the market value if this differs significantly from the price listed. If the cost of the replacement item is lower than the printed price, the lower price will be invoiced. Repairs to items not specifically referred to on the list will be charged at the invoice price, plus any call-out fees, disposal rates and VAT where appropriate.

In communal areas, where cleaning or repairs are necessary but the residents responsible do not identify themselves, the charge may be divided equally between all residents who use the area.
