The Dining Hall is the heart of the College, and has been the centre of St Hugh's College main building since it was built in 1914. The building was extended in 1955 the Second World War where the College was requisitioned by the military for use as the Hospital for Head Injuries.

The room is set with banquet tables, a raised Head table, and leads directly onto our Rose Terrace which is the perfect location for drinks on a summers evening.

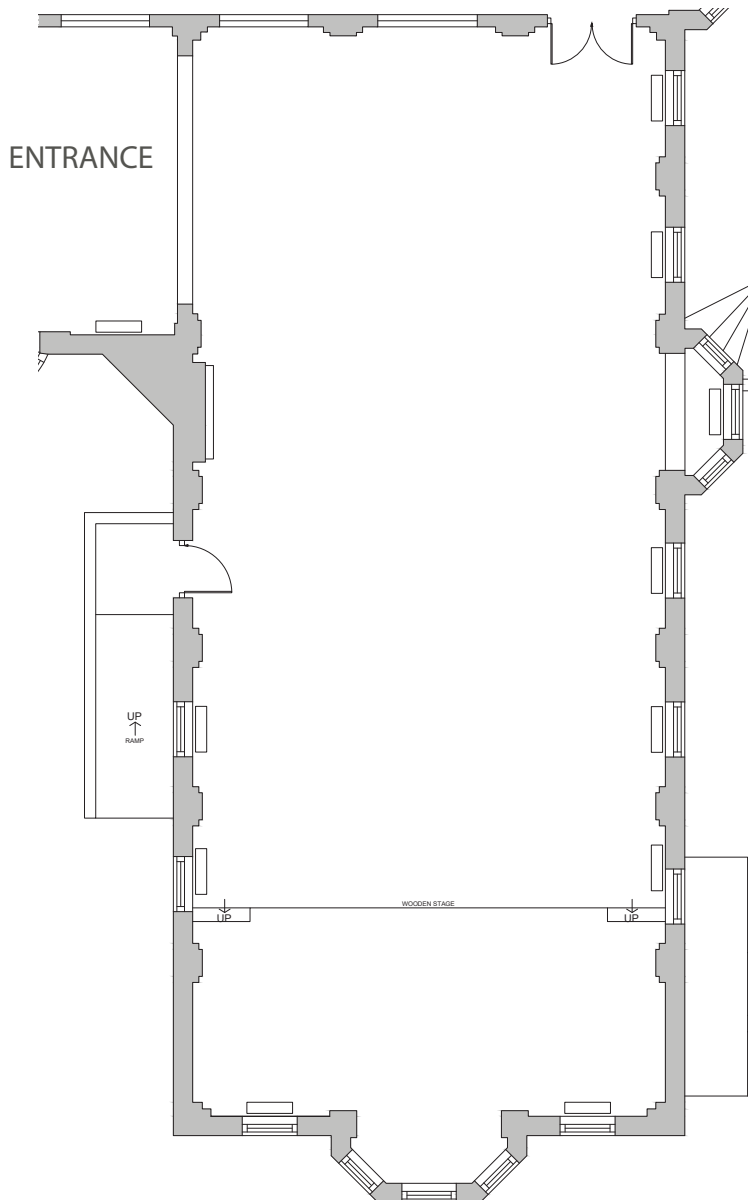
During term time this room is only available on Saturdays.
