The proposal for the Wolfson Centre, the working title for the project, was <u>received</u>. It was <u>agreed</u> to approve the project to develop the Wolfson Centre. It was further <u>agreed</u> to request the Principal to form a working group, reporting to Governing Body, to develop the brief, appoint architects and drive the project forward. The working group will comprise Fellows, other academic members, students and operational managers including the Head of Estates and Director of Development. Governing Body will receive regular reports from the working group and will remain the ultimate decision-making body for the duration of the project.

The Bursar <u>agreed</u> to prepare a business plan and to explore financing options for the short-term funding of the project, and the Director of Development <u>agreed</u> to develop and implement a fundraising campaign for the project.

From the discussion of the Wolfson Centre it was emphasised that this was a decision to proceed with the project and not a final decision about the completed design or contents of the Centre. It was also stressed that the fundraising activity had two parts, one the construction project and the other the creation of academic bursaries, scholarships and the endowment of posts.

While concerned about disruption and noise, the MCR and JCR were excited by the project, especially the refurbishment with en suite rooms and the possibility of improved gym and laundry facilities.

The Governing Body <u>thanked</u> the Director of Development and Bursar for their work on the project to date.
