The Principal and Fellows of St Hugh's College offer the Prize, worth up to £500, for the best historical essay submitted by a pupil who, at the closing date, has been in the Sixth Form of any school or college for a period of not more than two years. The winning essay will be published on the College's website.

The choice of historical subject is left to candidates.

Essays should be between two-thousand and four-thousand words and submitted by the candidate as a Microsoft Word document through the form on the College website:

Essays should be submitted by Friday 29th July 2016. The winner will be announced on the College website by the end of September 2016.
