



Outreach Photography Competition 2015



Following the success of the competition in previous years, we are again inviting students to submit photographs that could be used to promote St Hugh's to future applicants. Photos can be of anything related to College, with emphasis on photos which represent academic life.

Applicants may submit up to 15 different entries, taken at any point in your time at Oxford.

Each entrant will receive a **St Hugh's pencil** for taking part, and submitted photos may be used on the College website or in promotional material. The student who submits the best picture overall will receive a bottle of **Champagne** and have their photo put on display in College; the winner of the *academic life* category will receive **£20 in Amazon Vouchers**.

All images must be the original work of the entrant. The entrant must be the sole owner of the entire copyright in all images entered. It is the responsibility of the entrant, and not the College, to ensure that he or she complies with this requirement. By entering, entrants will be deemed to be bound by the rules and the College reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time if it has reason to believe that an entrant has breached the rules. If you have submitted a photograph of an individual or a group in a private setting, you must have obtained the person's prior consent. By entering the competition, you agree to your photographs (s) being used by St Hugh's College for the following purposes: (i) publication in the undergraduate print prospectus, (ii) publication on the St Hugh's website; and (iii) promotion of the St Hugh's College in any other media.

Photographic entries should be in colour with minimal digital manipulation; frames and text should not be present on the submitted images.

Photographs must be no larger than 10MB, and no smaller than 2MB.
